<p>概要</p> <p>When it comes to grammar instruction, teachers often rely on the traditional “knowledge transmission” style of teaching. It is efficient and easy to plan for and execute in the classroom. However, this style of teaching grammar is also one of the main reasons why students (AND teachers) actually dislike grammar instruction. This workshop will present some alternative approaches to grammar instruction which emphasize student-centeredness, communication and inductive reasoning (areas all emphasized in the MEXT course of study). By applying the principles of “active learning,” teachers will experience alternative ways to teach grammar that will engage and interest students while still achieving the grammar teaching objectives in their syllabus.</p>
